TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Promoter

2. Acceptance of Terms

By registering for and attending a Care Roadshow event, entrants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

3. Eligibility

3.1

4.1

4.2

5.1

5.4

5.5

Each colleague registered must also attend the relevant Care Roadshow event for the additional entry to be valid.

The colleague registered will also receive one (1) entry into the prize draw in their own right, provided they meet the eligibility criteria and attend the event.

There is no maximum number of additional entries that may be earned through colleague registrations, provided all registrations are genuine and all attendees meet the eligibility requirements.

5.8

The Promoter may request that the winner participates in reasonable publicity relating to the promotion.

8.2

Participation in publicity is voluntary and is not a condition of receiving the prize.

Any personal data supplied during the course of this promotion will be processed by the Promoter solely for the purposes of:

- Verifying eligibility
- Managing entries
- Contacting the winner
- Delivering the prize

9.2

Personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation and the Promoter's Privacy Policy.

10. Limitation of Liability

10.1

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to technical faults, network failures, hardware or software failures or other reasons beyond its reasonable control.

10.2

Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes or limits the Promoter's liability for death or personal injury caused by its negligence, fraud, fraudulent misrepresentation or any other liability which cannot be excluded by law.

11. General

11.1

The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, suspend, amend or withdraw the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

11.2

The Promoter's decision in respect of all matters relating to the promotion shall be final.

11.3

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
